Each spelling word list is available in three levels (core, entry, and exit) to assist teachers in providing differentiated content. Teachers can also **create or import their own word list**, **spelling courses**, and **edit individual word** lists when modifications and extensions are required. There are also ready-to-go complete sets of Dolch and Fry's word lists to target spelling of high-frequency words and sight words.
